

**SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL
(PARISH OF CLAYDON) (OLD IPSWICH ROAD) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF
WAITING) ORDER 201-**

Suffolk County Council proposes to make the above order for Claydon under Sections 1, 2, and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The effect of the order is to:

- Extend no waiting at any time on the east side of Old Ipswich Road from the end of the double yellow lines at the junction with The Beeches to a point opposite Old Paper Mill Lane.
- Prohibit waiting Monday – Friday 1:00 p.m. – 2:00 p.m. on the west side of Old Ipswich Road:
 - Between The Beeches and the southern boundary of Hillside Cottage.
 - From a point opposite Foxearth Cottage in a northerly direction for a distance of 32 metres, adjacent to Claydon Court.

Exemptions to the waiting restrictions allow a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary to board or alight; for loading and unloading; for building, industrial or demolition works; for the maintenance of the road or its services; and for fulfilling statutory duties. The usual arrangements apply for blue badge-holders.

In association with this order bus stop clearways are to be provided at the existing bus stops adjacent to Claydon Court and opposite Orchard Grove (no stopping except buses).

Please note that any such correspondence cannot be regarded as confidential and may be inspected by any interested party.
