The following application were discussed:-

##### a. **DC/19/02821**

APPLICATION FOR CONSENT TO CARRY OUT WORKS TO TREE(S) PROTECTED BY A TREE PRESERVATION ORDER

**Proposal:** Notification of Works to Trees Protected by a Preservation Order - T1 (1no. Beech) - Reduce crown to previous points, removing 2 metres and to raise the crown to 6 metres.

**Location:** 2 Chestnut Drive, Claydon, Ipswich, Suffolk IP6 0EU

Parish councillors had no objections to this application.

##### b. **SCC/0059/19MS/VOC**

**Proposal:** Variation of condition 43 of permission MS/210/11 to increase operational capacity from 269,000t per annum to 295,000t per annum.

**Location:** Great Blakenham Energy from Waste, Lodge Lane, Great Blakenham, Ipswich, IP6 0JE

Parish councillors supported this application.
