Planning Applications

Planning Applications 1856/17 for 269 houses in Church Lane, Barham and DC/18/00861 for 73 houses in Ely Road, Claydon have been strongly opposed by both Parish Councils and many residents. These are due to be discussed at the Planning Committee for Mid Suffolk District Council together because of the cumulative impact both applications will have on Claydon and Barham. Members of the public are able to attend this meeting, which is likely to be held online. The date for the Planning Committee will be published by Mid Suffolk District Council one week before the meeting and the Parish Council will ensure that this is well publicised on the website, our social media feeds and on our noticeboards.
