Following negotiation by the Parish Council, Suffolk Highways have agreed to clean up the road in the centre of Claydon following the works from Anglian Water and repaint the lines on the road so that parking is clearly visible.

Parish Precept

The Parish Council resolved to set its precept as £41,360 for the year March 2020 – April 2021 at the meeting on 13 January. This precept gives the Parish a Council Tax Band D amount of £52.58 which is an increase of 0.05% on 2019/20.
