PL-06-20-10. Landscape and Wildlife Evaluation

Cllr Price had been in contact with the Otley Neighbourhood Plan Group regarding a landscape and wildlife evaluation that they had commissioned from Suffolk Wildlife Trust. The report suggested different ways that the land could be used and what it is and is not suitable for. The report was extensive and cost £1800 last year.

Councillors felt that this might be useful and it was suggested to add this to the next full Parish Council meeting agenda following further investigation by Cllr Price.

It was suggested that it would be useful to investigate whether Barham Parish Council would like to join together for this report.

PL-06-20-11. Items for next meeting

Councillors considered a notification from the Conservation Coordinator that further work needs to be carried out in the conservation area. The clerk was requested to obtain a quote for this work for consideration by councillors.

The state of the footpaths around Claydon was noted and this will be discussed at the next Parish Council meeting.

A question was raised regarding whether any chemicals had been used on the Recreation Ground. Cllr Avis confirmed that in early May, fertilizer and grass seed had been used, but nothing further.

The meeting closed at 8.11pm
