CLAYDON AND WHITTON PARISH COUNCIL EXTRAORDINARY MEETING

02-21-01. Opening

Councillor Studd opened the meeting.

02-21-02. Public Forum

No members of the public wished to speak.

Cllr Studd declared that he is a governor of Claydon High School. Councillors agreed that he had no financial interest, but it was agreed that he would not vote on item 02-21-05.

02-21-05. Purchase of Chromebooks for Claydon High School

Cllr Whitehead explained that the disbanded Claydon Youth Club had a left over balance of £1,000, which could be put towards a laptop fund for disadvantaged young people.

Great Blakenham Parish Council has donated four Chromebooks to the school for use with disadvantaged young people in Great Blakenham.

The proposal would be for laptops to be given to the school, to be loaned to disadvantaged young people and then the school to collect them back in for use in future lockdowns or as part of school stock. The school will manage allocating Wi-Fi, loading up the Chromebooks and interacting with families in need.

The school have identified the families that are in need of this equipment within the parish.

Parish Councillors voted in favour of donating IT equipment to Claydon High School.

Parish Councillors agreed that there would be a maximum contribution of £1,000 and that the clerk would check with the school whether they would rather purchase the equipment themselves or ask us to purchase the IT equipment.
